



Hey, Uncle Bumper. What are you thinking about?

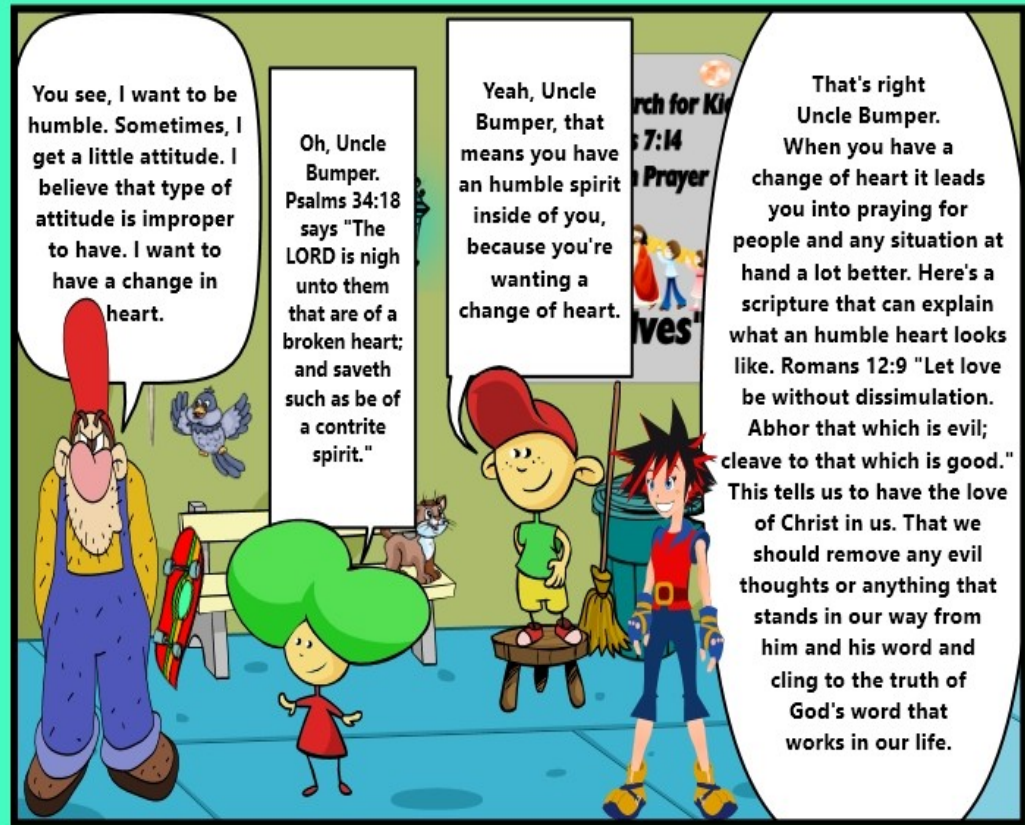
Well, I saw your poster here and it shows this weeks study is all about humbling ourselves. I am kind of interested in what's going to be said.

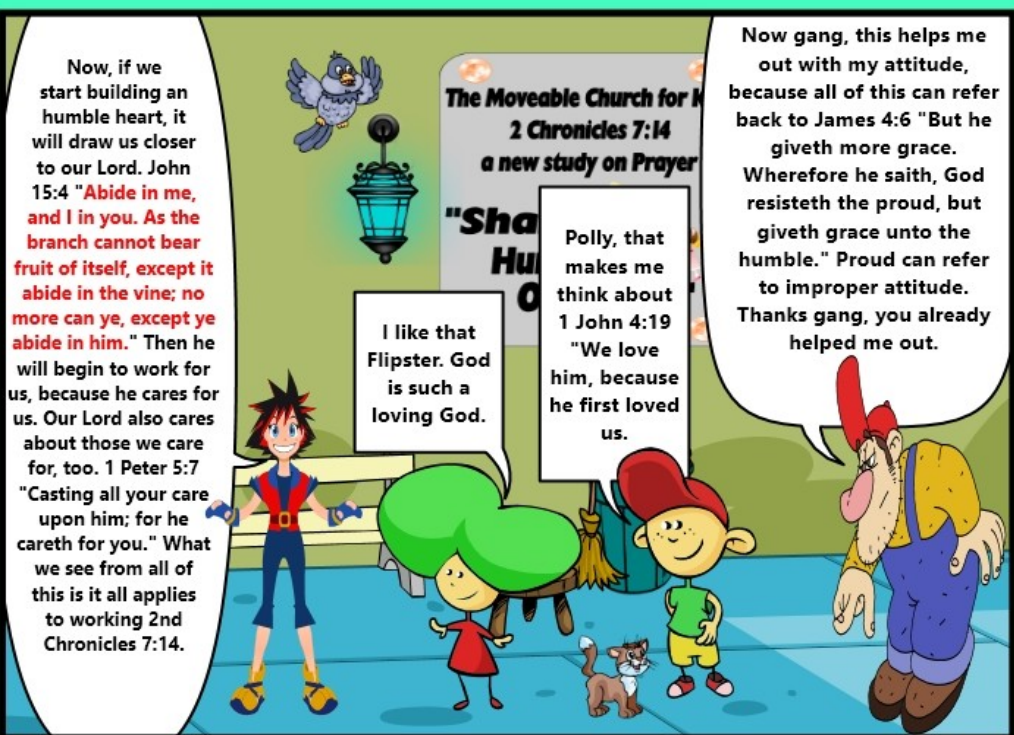


You see, I want to be humble. Sometimes, I get a little attitude. I believe that type of attitude is improper to have. I want to have a change in heart.

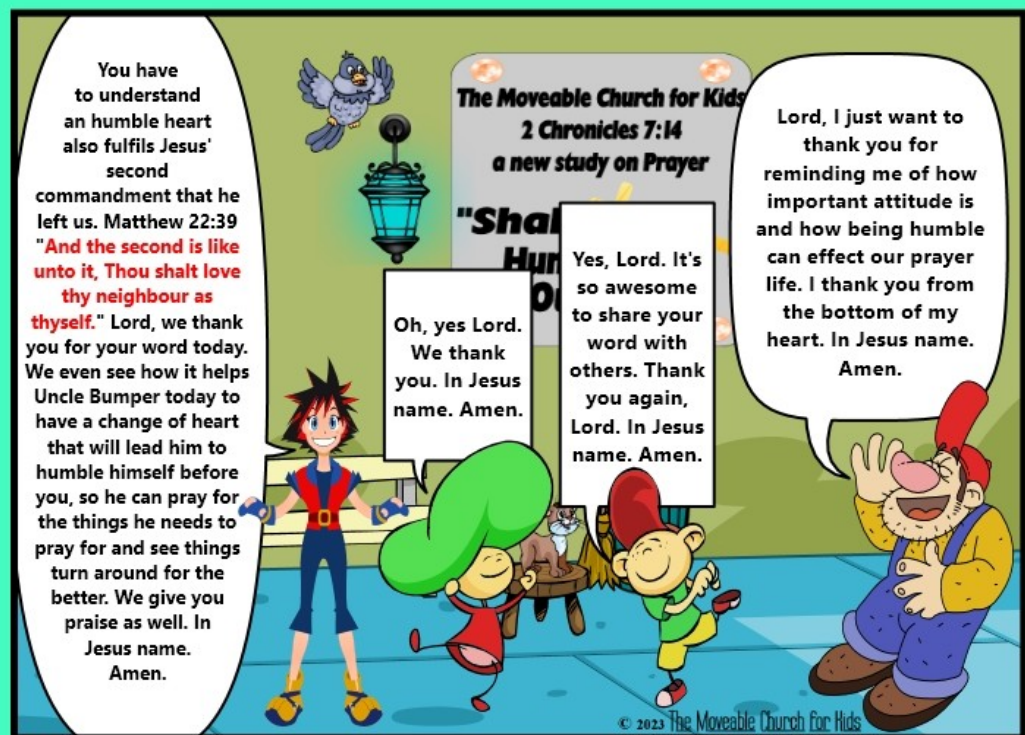
