

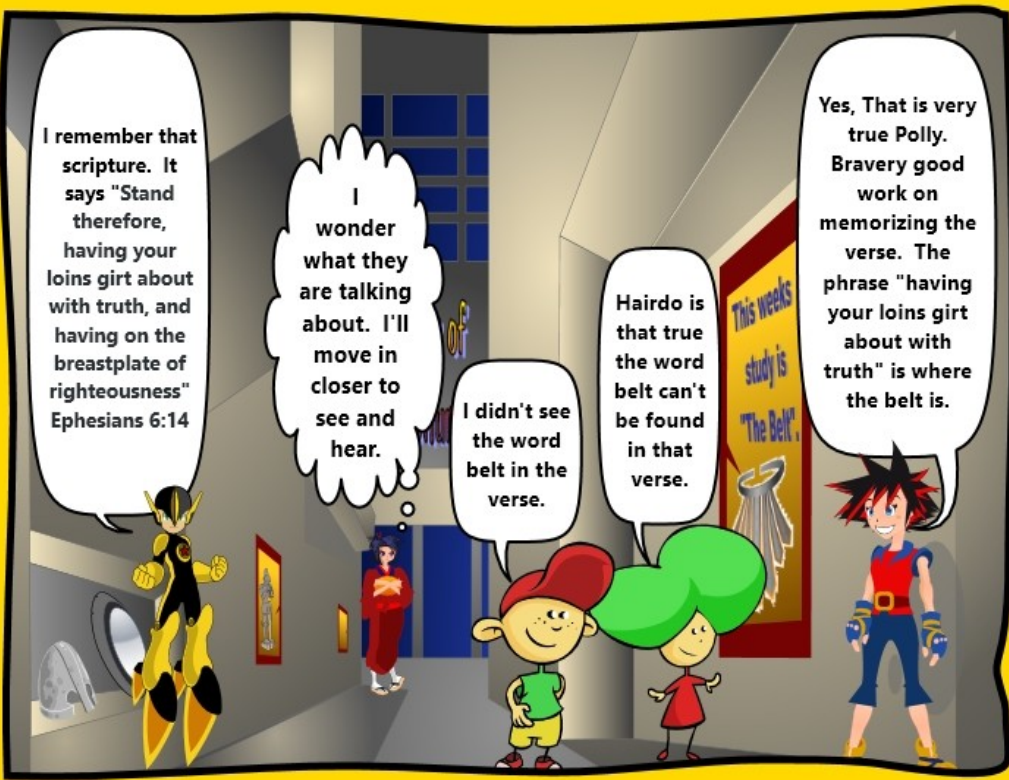


Hey Gang! What are you guys looking at?

Yes, it is strange looking, but that's how some of the warrior belts looked in those days. Ephesians 6:14 talks about the belt of truth.



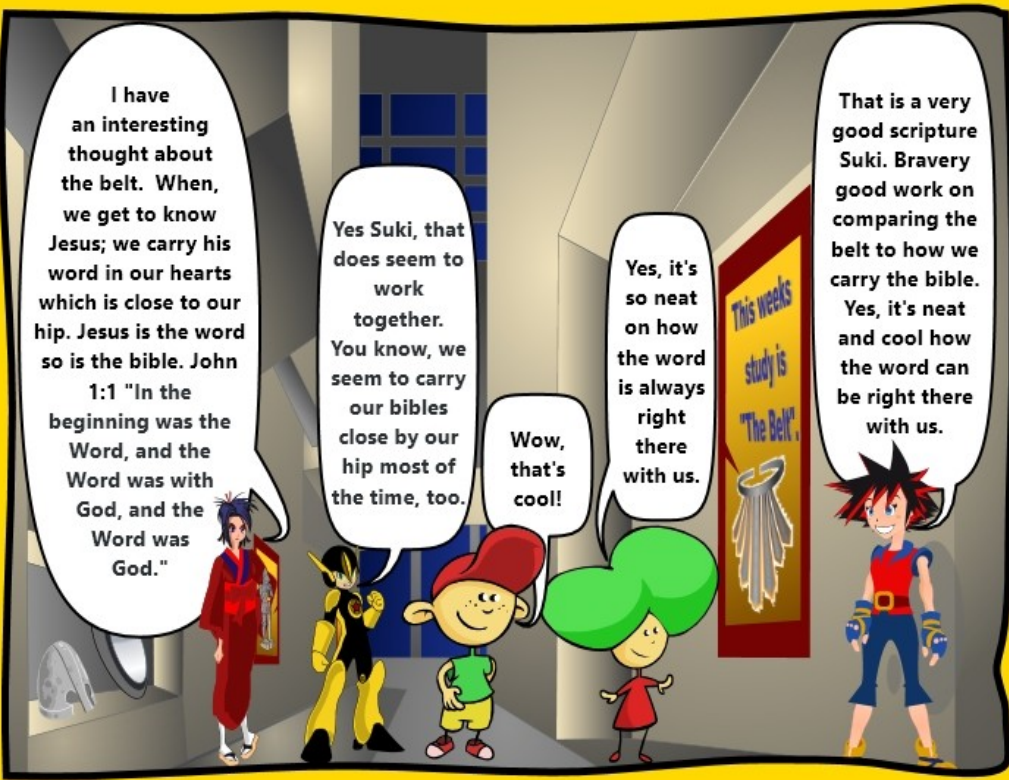
I remember that scripture. It says "Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness" Ephesians 6:14
