HELL AND ETERNAL RETRIBUTION

One must believe in their heart and confess with their mouth that Jesus is Lord (Rom. 10: 9-10) in order to be saved and should be accompanied or followed by water baptism. For the person who physically dies without believing in the Lord Jesus and making such confession no longer has opportunity of hearing the Gospel and is forever lost in the lake of fire.

The terms “eternal” and “everlasting” apply literally to both the damned and the saints of God. The duration for the damned in the lake of fire exists eternally as well as an eternal duration of joy for the saints in the presence of God.
