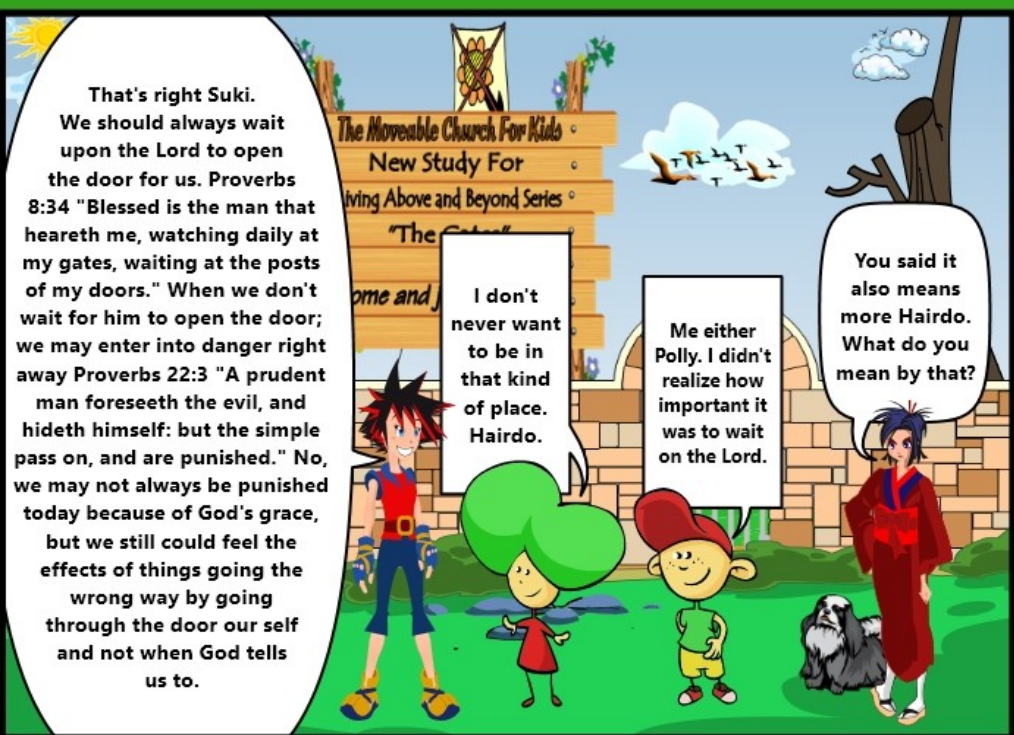

This means God should be opening the door for us?

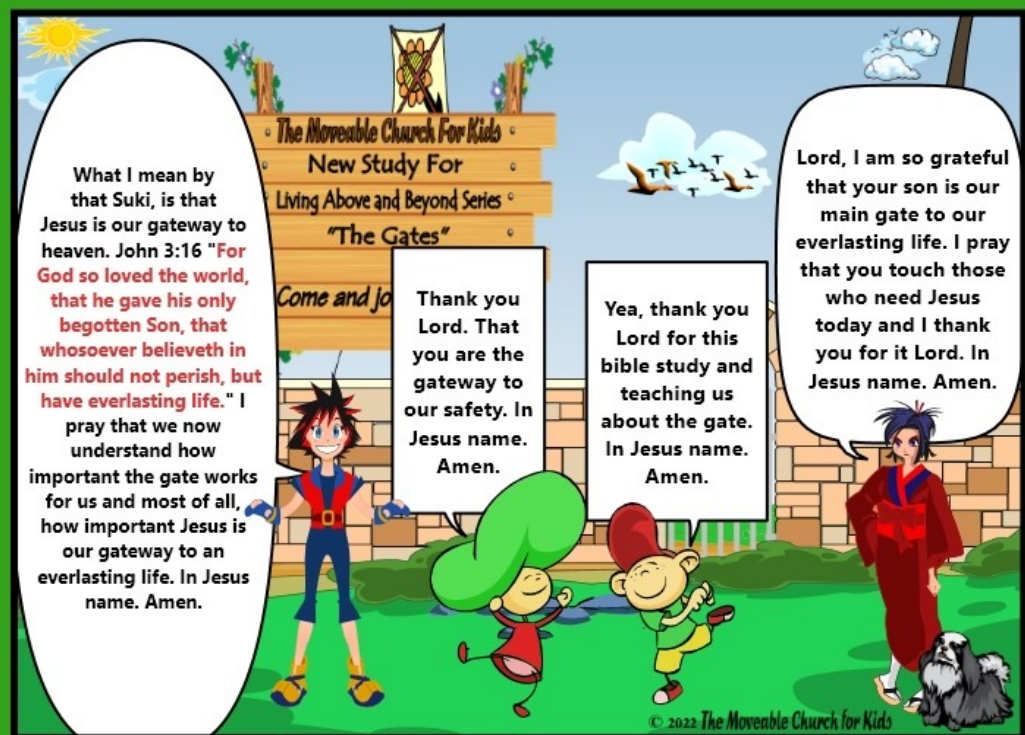
