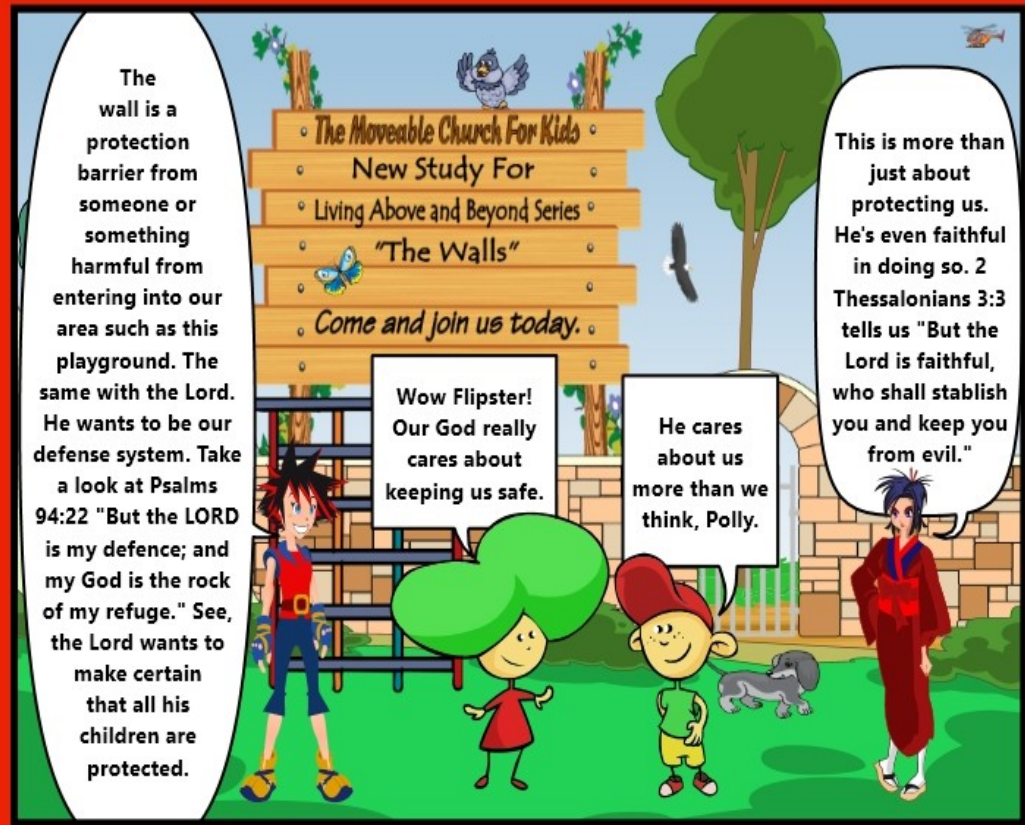


Look Flipster, there is a sign about the new bible study and it's about the wall. I wonder what that could mean?

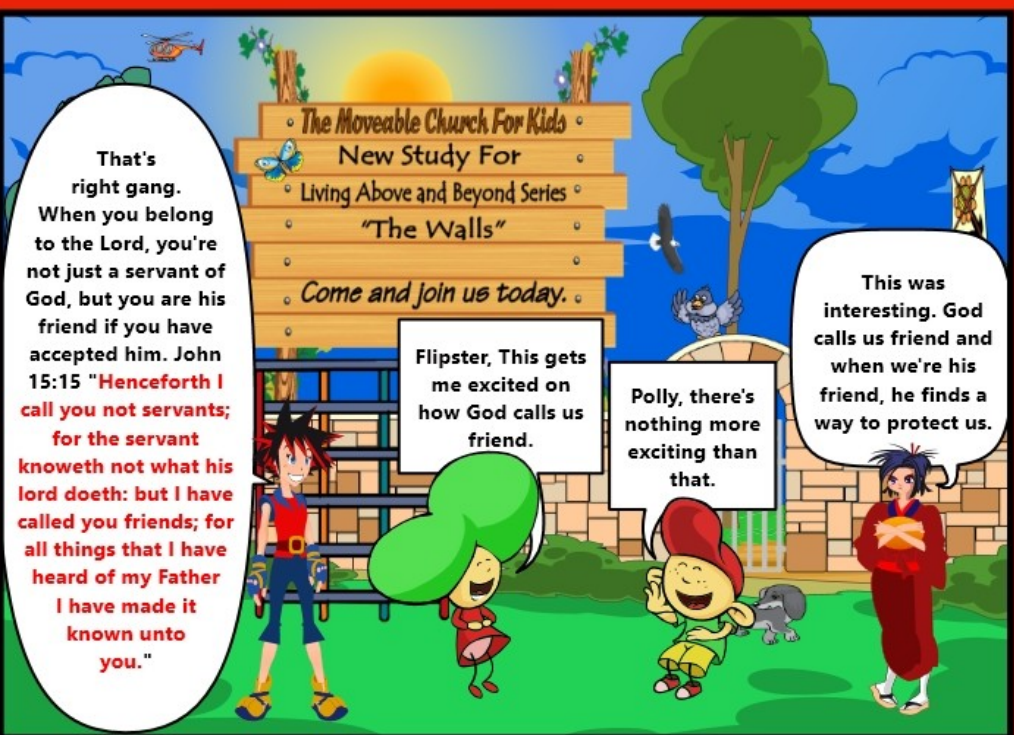

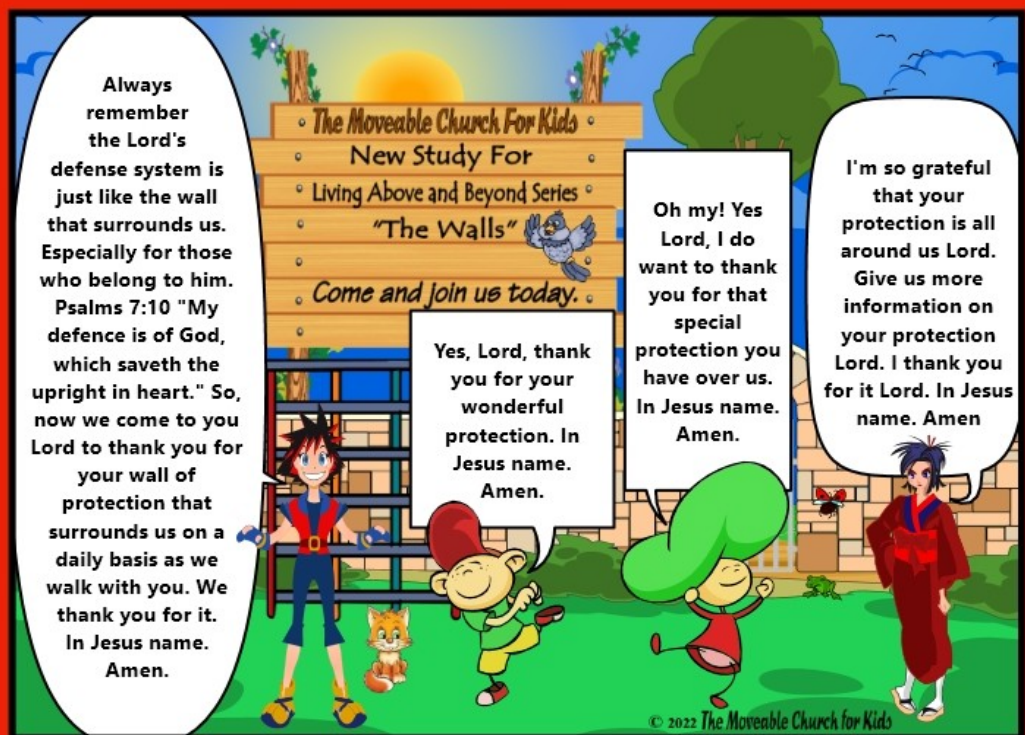
